ENTRY CRITERIA: Applicants must:

• Be 18 years of age or above

- Have completed NCEA Level 2 or Senior Secondary or equivalent/above
- English language competence in either; IELTS (General or Academic) 5.5 with no score less than 5, or NZCEL Level 3 (Applied) or PToE 42 (Academic) with no score less than 36 or equivalent on https://www.nzqa.govt.nz/about-us/our-role/legislation/nzqa-rules/nzqf-related-rules/the-table
- Be physically fit to complete practical aspects of the course
- Comply with the NZ Immigration requirements for a student visa.

WORK RIGHTS: Currently, this qualification is included in immediate skill shortage category, and students are eligible to work for 20 hours per week during study and full-time during scheduled vacations.
