ENTRY CRITERIA: Applicants must:

- Be 18 years of age or above
- Have completed NCEA Level 2 or Senior Secondary or equivalent/above
- English language competence in either; IELTS (Academic) 5.5 with no score less than 5, <u>or</u> NZCEL Level 4 (General or Employment) <u>or</u> PToE 42 (Academic) with no score less than36 <u>or</u> equivalent on <u>https://www.nzqa.govt.nz/about-us/our-role/legislation/nzqa-rules/nzqf-related-rules/the-table</u>
- Be physically fit to complete practical aspects of the course
- Have adequate work experience preferably in horticulture
- Comply with the NZ Immigration requirements for a student visa.
